DIRECTIONS TO ASSESSORS AND TAX COLLECTORS.

EXEMPT FROM TAXATION.—The King, the Queen, the Diplomatic Agents of Foreign Governments and their attaches, duly made known to the Department of Foreign Relations, are exempt from all internal taxation. Real or personal property up to three hundred dollars in valuation is exempt from taxation.

All property must be assessed in the district in which it is situated, for its full cash value, irrespective of any mortgage. Every person having the custody or possession of a horse or other animal, or other personal property subject to taxation, shall be deemed the owner thereof, and shall be taxed for the same.

TAX ON REAL ESTATE.—Real Estate includes all lands and town lots, with the buildings, structures, and other things erected on, or affixed to the same, and is subject to a tax of seventy-five cents upon every one hundred dollars of its assessed value. *Exceptions.*—Real Estate belonging to the Government, to the Board of Education for the use of schools, to incorporated or private schools, to the Queen's Hospital, to religious societies for church sites not to exceed an acre in area, and burying grounds.

TAX ON PERSONAL PROPERTY.—Personal Property includes all animals, household furniture, goods and chattels not specifically taxed, wares and merchandise, all ships and vessels whether at home or abroad, all moneys, notes of hand, unsecured debts, growing crops, public stocks, and every other species of property not included in real estate, and is subject to a tax of seventy-five cents upon every one hundred dollars of its assessed value. Leasehold interests must be assessed as personal property against the owner of the beneficial interests therein, whether such leases are of Government or Crown Lands or otherwise. *Exceptions.*—Personal property belonging to the Board of Education for the use of schools, to incorporated or private schools, to the Queen's Hospital and to the Government.

CARRIAGE TAX.—All carriages and wagons drawn by one or more horses or mules, used for the conveyance of persons, are subject to an annual tax of five dollars each.

POLL TAX.—Every male inhabitant of the Kingdom, between the ages of seventeen and sixty years, whether a subject or an alien, is subject to an annual poll tax of one dollar. *Exceptions.*—All clergymen of any Christian denomination (not Mormons) regularly engaged in their vocation; all teachers of youth employed in public or private schools for more than six months of the year; soldiers, regulars or volunteers, in actual service, or doing duty as active members of any

duly authorized, organized and accepted corps; members of the Fire Department, and persons exempted by the assessor of the district on account of age, infirmity and poverty.

ANIMAL TAX.—All animals are taxed without regard to age. All horses, mares and colts shall pay a yearly tax of seventy-five cents each. All dogs pay a yearly tax of one dollar and ten cents for a tag. *Exceptions.*—Animals belonging to the Government; firemen and mounted soldiers are entitled to an exemption from taxation on two horses.

SCHOOL TAX.—Every male inhabitant of the Kingdom between the ages of twenty and sixty years, whether a subject or an alien, is liable to an annual tax of two dollars each.

Exceptions.—Clergymen of any Christian denomination (not Mormons), regularly engaged in their vocation; teachers of youth in public or private schools for more than six months of the year; and all students actually in attendance at high schools or colleges; soldiers, regulars or volunteers; members of the fire department; and persons exempted by the assessors of the district on account of age, infirmity or poverty.

ROAD TAX.—Every male inhabitant of the Kingdom, between the ages of seventeen and fifty years, whether a subject or an alien, is subject to an annual road tax of two dollars each. All carts and drays shall pay a tax of two dollars.

Exceptions.—Clergymen actually employed in their vocation; teachers of youth in public or private schools for more than six months of the year; students in actual attendance at any high school or college; soldiers, regulars or volunteers; members of the fire department; and persons exempted by the assessors on account of infirmity.

NOTE.—Hawaiian sailors, in vessels bound on foreign voyages, whether native or naturalized, commute for all their personal taxes at the time of shipment, and consequently are liable only for the tax on their real and personal property, their animals and carriages.

Consuls of foreign nations are not exempted from taxation by the laws of this Kingdom, or by the laws of nations.

ASSESSORS.—Assessors should commence their work as soon after July 1st as possible; but should first take the required oath, a copy of which must be sent to the Minister of Finance, as no assessor can receive pay for his services until this is done. Forms for assessment lists should be presented to property holders to be filled and sworn to. Assessors should call upon persons to ascertain the amount of taxes each is liable to pay; or give public notice by written or printed advertisement to the inhabitants to meet him at convenient points in the district for that purpose. If any person shall

fail to give the Assessor his sworn list of property liable to taxation, or to give information of the same, until the 1st day of September, the Assessor will make the assessment up from the best information he can obtain, and the same shall be binding on all parties. Assessors should, on or before the 1st day of September, give written notice to all owners of real estate in their district who are non-residents of the district and in this Kingdom, describing the property assessed and the proposed valuation.

Assessors should fill out all the columns on the left hand pages only, and must foot all the columns, except the first and second, and prove the footings, in order to avoid mistakes. When the pages are all footed and proved they must recapitulate the footings by pages, writing only on left hand pages. When the books are completed they must, before passing them to the Governor, take and subscribe before a Police or District Justice an oath, to be written on the 1st page of each book, stating that "This Book is the Assessment Book for the District of.....in the Island of....., for the year 1880." Assessors should use every means in their power to ascertain the values of property, noting improvements made since last assessment, and not follow the book of the year before too closely. Immediately after the 1st of September, the books must be closed and sent to the Governor.

TAX COLLECTORS.—Tax Collectors should commence their work as soon after the 1st day of September as possible, first filing with the Governor a bond with two sureties to the Minister of Finance in a sum equal to the amount of taxes to be collected by them, as shown by the assessment list. The Collector should call on each tax payer in his district at his residence, or usual place of business, or post written or printed notice to the tax payers to meet him at convenient places in his district during the months of September, October, and November, to demand payment of taxes as assessed. The Tax Collector should add to his list any person or property in his district not included in his list, liable to assessment, and collect the taxes upon the same, entering them in a separate part of his book as "Taxes not Assessed." They should be careful to note all persons qualified to vote in the proper column, and should carefully fill all columns requiring to be filled, on the right hand pages only. They will deliver to each person paying the dog tax a tag, charging ten cents for the same, entering the number of the tag and amount received.

Should any person deem his assessment too high, and de-

sire to appeal to the Tax Appeal Board, the Tax Collector will, up to the last day of November, furnish such tax payer with a certificate of appeal, upon payment of costs as follows: When the reduction or exemption claimed amounts to two dollars or less, fifty cents; over two dollars and under five dollars, one dollar; over five and not more than ten dollars, two dollars; and for every additional five dollars or part of five dollars, one dollar additional. The costs so paid to be returned to the person appealing in case the appeal is sustained by the Board, but if not sustained, the costs are to be paid to the Governor, to be accounted for to the Treasury as fines and penalties. The Tax Collector may grant to persons disabled by sickness or bodily injury certificates of appeal for personal taxes only without payment of costs. On the 1st day of December, Tax Collectors shall commence legal proceedings against delinquent tax payers, except in cases where certificates of appeal have been granted, when he shall wait until the 16th day of December, before commencing legal proceedings. In cases where, after using due diligence, taxes cannot be collected, the Tax Collector must file with the Governor a sworn list containing names and places of residence so far as can be ascertained, and amount due by each person. Tax Collectors must, on or before the last day of December, on the year preceding an election for Representatives, make out a list of persons qualified to vote, and pass the same to the inspectors of election.

When the collection is finished the Tax Collector must carefully add all the columns on each page, proving the correctness of each and recapitulate the footings by pages, on the right hand pages only.

The footings of the column of "Auhau Kula" will show the amount of taxes to be paid the School Treasurer of the district, from whom a receipt in duplicate should be taken, one of which should be sent to the President of the Board of Education. On filing with the School Treasurer an oath, taken before a Magistrate, that the amount of school tax entered in his book is all that he has been able to collect, and a sworn list containing the names of persons from whom he has been unable to collect the tax, with their place of residence so far as may be known, the School Treasurer will pay the commission allowed by law on the amount. The footings of the column "Houluulu o na Auhau Mau" will show the amount to be paid the Governor, and upon filing with the Governor a like oath and list, the Governor will pay the commission allowed by law on the amount.

The Collector's book should be in the hands of the Governor on or before the last day of December.
