The Kona Historical Society offers a beautiful pasture setting for any special event. Our Kalukalu site is located at a cool elevation (1500 feet) and includes an ocean view, native plant forest, majestic monkeypod and magnolia trees, an authentic Portuguese stone oven, stone ruins, and the historic H.N. Greenwell Store that dates from 1870.



The pasture and old trees, the stone structures, and the view of the ocean beyond, provide many beautiful venues for ceremonies and photographs.
